CALL FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR A GRANTS MANAGEMENT TRAINER

Uganda Youth Network (UYONET) is a leading national umbrella organization for youth in Uganda with a network of 157 youth organisations and partners working with young people across the country. Over the years, UYONET has built and sustained partnerships with a cross section of non-state agencies, governments, extensive media partnerships and regional bodies, played a strategic role in empowering youth leaders in politics, civil society and other sectors to advocate effectively on issues of youth concern.

UYONET is implementing a DGF funded project ‘ Strengthening the youth sector to engage in democratic and decision making processes’ which is a three year project that aims at contributing towards building a well-coordinated, effective and responsive youth sector. The project will improve the lives of various categories of youth across the spectrum including youth leaders of informal and formal groups, youth working in the informal sector. The three year project intends to realize three key outputs thus; (1) Youth leaders demonstrate improved leadership principles and practices of effective meaningful engagement in governance processes (2) Development programs and policies that are responsive to the actual needs of youth (3) Vibrant Youth CSOs and players actively articulating youth priorities at all levels.

In implementing the project, UYONET is working with its member organisations and other youth organisations at both sub national and national levels including building relationships with state and non-state actors, religious and cultural institutions in achieving the set objectives. Among the different approaches being used include support to member organisations to implement local advocacy initiatives that feed into the UYONET strategic plan and National Youth Manifesto 2016-2021. This involves subcontracting member organizations to implement their local initiatives that contribute to the UYONET strategic plan and National Youth manifesto.

Reference to the above, UYONET is seeking applications from suitable and professional Grants management trainers from preferably civil society to facilitate the grants management training of selected member organisations that shall later be subcontracted to implement local initiatives aligned to the UYONET strategy and the National Youth Manifesto.

Areas of training

- Finance management
- Project implementation and management
- Monitoring and evaluation

Mode of Delivery

- i. Main language for delivery is English
- ii. Participatory methods of delivery during the training including group work
- iii. Pre and post methods of evaluation

Eligibility / Selection Criteria:

- i. Prior experience in conducting similar trainings
- ii. Minimum qualification of a bachelor's degree from a reputable institution of higher learning in a relevant field
- iii. Understanding of NGO work and relevant dynamics in especially youth work

Application requirements:

- i. An up to date CV including evidence of handling and delivery of similar trainings
- ii. Technical and financial proposal on mode of delivery of the 3 days training
